### **TO ALL GRADUATING SENIOR STUDENTS OF BAY HIGH**

The Bay Men's Club will provide two college scholarship grants to graduating seniors from Bay High School.

**AMOUNT OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP** - \$ 1,000.00

### **PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

To provide financial assistance to qualified seniors of Bay High who desire education beyond the high school level.

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE**

Any senior boy or girl who is attending Bay High School and who is planning on attending an Ohio state supported college or university.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

The award will be based upon need, character, attainment of a 3.0 plus scholastic average during his or her Bay High career, activities in the local community and school activities.

### **RECIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

If for any reason or circumstance the winner is prevented from attending a state college or university of his or her choice, the scholarship will revert to the Bay Men's Club Past Presidents Scholarship Committee and will be awarded to a runner-up.

### **HOW APPLICATION IS MADE**

Application blanks, which are available at the Bay High School Guidance Department Office, should be completed and returned to the office no later than April 15th.

### **HOW THE WINNERS ARE SELECTED**

Selection will be made by a panel of three Past Presidents of the Community Club of Bay Village (Bay Men's Club), who will base their decision upon careful consideration of the student's application and Bay High School records. A transcript of grades will be required. Complete and detailed information on the application is required for this evaluation.
